This position is funded by Canada Summer Jobs. Eligible candidates must be between 15 and 30 years of age, and eligible to work in Canada. This position goes from July 1 to August 31.

Qualifications:

- Have an interest in the history of the Entwistle and Evansburg area.
- Ability to work independently and in a team.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Strong interpersonal skills.
- Comfortable working with people of all ages, including children.
- Experience working in customer service or a public-facing role is an asset.
- Computer skills in Microsoft Office, Google Suite, and Canva are an asset.
- Certification in First Aid/CPR an asset.

Job Duties:

- Assist with delivering community programs. This includes working with children, doing crafts and playing games, helping prepare crafts and activities, and providing an educational experience.

- Learn about how to care for collections and archival materials, and assist with collections tasks.
- Assist with gift shop sales and tidying.
